

CROWLEY'S RIDGE COLLEGE CURRENT FUNDING NEEDS – (Updated September 12, 2018)

THESE ARE PRIORITY NEEDS FOR WHICH CRC IS SEEKING IMMEDIATE FUNDING

- **\$4,800,000** – Dormitory Construction cost for 3 phases of 60 beds @ \$1.8 + \$1.5 + \$1.5 million for total of 180 beds.
- **\$845,000** – To pay the current unfunded portion of Scholarships awarded to CRC students this year. We are thankful to receive about \$145,000 annually in Scholarship donations. These scholarship gifts are a tremendous blessing to our students and are awarded for Bible majors, academic achievements, music, drama, athletics, and for a variety of specialized areas/needs. This year, CRC will provide students with more than \$990,000 in Scholarship awards making their cost of attending College more affordable.
- **\$350,000** – Construction cost for 3,740 square feet educational facility with classrooms, offices, restrooms, and storage.
- **\$187,306** – Total cost of Wilson Hall interior renovation of the dorm rooms, bathrooms, hallways, ceiling tiles/fixtures and stairway fixtures for both women/men's wings.
- **\$125,000** – Landscape interior of pond, including brick or block next to water and Mary House Project with Bell Tower renovation with park area also near/connecting to pond.
- **\$100,000** – Infrastructure replacements; replacing 6-inch main waterlines and fire hydrants. 1st stage from Physical Sciences Building to Jennie Sue Eubanks Cafeteria is approximately 900 ft @ estimated cost of \$35,000. At least two more 6-inch main waterline sections will need to be replaced following this 1st Infrastructure Replacement Phase.
- **\$87,000** – Complete upgrade of the interior sidewalls and roof ceiling of the Carter Activities Center.
- **\$47,428** – Install new 24 gauge metal standing seam roof on Winter's Hall.
- **\$25,000** – Reshaping large gully between collegiate baseball and softball fields, including adding pipes, smaller tree/brush removal, and making into a park like setting.
- **\$22,280** – Correct roof line and install new 24 gauge metal standing seam roof on Wilson Hall.
- **\$15,580** – Computer Technology/Desks for Classroom. 26 student workstations/1 teacher workstation with virtual devices, monitors, keyboards, and mouse devices. \$6,400 for computer style desks with 27 seating capacity, \$3,510 for monitors, \$5,400 for virtual devices (connects on back of monitors), and \$270 for keyboards and mouse devices.
- **\$12,360** – Replacing old 2x4 ceiling tile inside Cafeteria with new 2x2 ceiling tile and grids. This will greatly improve the look of kitchen and dining areas. New flooring has just been installed.
- **\$7,250** – Battle of the Youth Groups: 3 day event for 7th-12th graders to encourage attending college. Expenses for food, activities and event t-shirt. Approximately 150 youth enjoy indoor/outdoor team building activities, variety of games, plus a night at movies and bowling.
- **\$6,836** – Purchase and install LED lighting for Carter Activities Center.
- **\$6,495** – Purchase scoreboard for Pioneer baseball field.
- **\$5,695** – Purchase scoreboard for Pioneer softball field.
- **\$5,100** – Library automation software and first year annual fee. Numerous benefits increasing CRC's library resources.
- **\$4,810** – Pioneer softball field landscaping.
- **\$4,800** – Developmental English software. Helps in areas of assignments, immediate/constructive feedback, reinforcing key concepts, encouraging reading/writing, individualized study paths, and progress monitoring. 80 units @ \$60 each.
- **\$4,500** – Pioneer baseball field landscaping.
- **\$2,505** – Purchase Pioneer canopy needed for collegiate activities, other student activities, and campus events.

\$6,664,945 is the total needed to pay for all the items listed above.
