



CRC Accreditation

Crowley’s Ridge College was accredited, in 2019, based on the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) Standards, for a two year period that extended through 2021 at the initial-level for *K-6 Elementary Education* and *K-12 Physical Education/Coaching*. The focused visit was held in 2021 to decide on full accreditation until 2026. The Division of Teacher Education was granted full accreditation at the initial-licensure level until Spring 2026. This includes the programs of *K-6 Elementary Education* and *K-12 Physical Education/Coaching*.

Crowley’s Ridge College of Education has earned national accreditation by demonstrating excellence in the areas of content and pedagogy, clinical experiences, selectivity, program impact, and capacity for continuous improvement. CAEP is the sole national accreditor for educator preparation nationwide.
