Some of our buildings and facilities have been built in recent years, while others are a number of years old but have been well maintained and continue to serve CRC's needs well. To give you a better idea of the funding required to maintain our facilities, the Carter Activities Center was recently renovated. The total cost for these interior and exterior improvements was just over \$250,000. Other facility improvements are slated in the future to replace the roofs for the Jennie Sue Eubanks Cafeteria, Wilson Hall, and Winters Hall, and a variety of interior and exterior improvements to these and other buildings.

Annual gifts and an endowed fund for building maintenance, improvements, and new facilities are both needed. These types of gifts will help CRC maintain and improve facilities, and add new facilities as we continue to grow in every department due to further increases in our enrollment numbers. This student growth will require us to expand and add facilities for academics, Bible, chapel, auditorium, athletics, and other student life areas.
