CRC also offers an Associate of Arts in General Studies in conjunction with Harding University leading to a Bachelor degree in this area:

- Associate of Arts at CRC to Bachelor of Arts in Speech-Language Pathology Assistant at Harding University

Additionally, CRC offers an Associate of Science in General Studies in conjunction with agreements with Harding University and Freed-Hardeman University leading to Bachelor degrees in these areas:

- Associate of Science at CRC to Bachelor of Science in Biology at Freed-Hardeman
- Associate of Science at CRC to Bachelor of Science in Chemistry at Freed-Hardeman
- Associate of Science at CRC to Bachelor of Science in Nursing at Freed-Hardeman

Finally, CRC offers an Bachelor of Arts in General Studies in conjunction with Harding University leading to a Bachelor and Doctorate degrees in these areas:

- Bachelor of Arts (in 3 years) at CRC to Doctorate of Pharmacy at Harding University
