According to the published federal regulations governing EADA reporting, a participant is defined as a student-athlete who, as of the day of a varsity team's first scheduled contest – (a) is listed by the institution on the varsity team's roster; or (b) receives athletically related student aid; or (c) practices with the varsity team and receives coaching from one or more varsity coaches. Any student-athlete who satisfies one or more of these criteria is a participant, including a student on a team the institution designates or defines as a junior varsity, freshman, or novice, or a student withheld from competition to preserve eligibility (i.e. a redshirt) or for academic, medical, or other medical reasons.
