In the spring 2009 CRC Insider, I wrote concerning two topics that I predicted would have a significant impact on the future of CRC: (1) The construction of the new Student Center and (2) CRC becoming a four year college granting Bachelor's Degrees. What has happened in the last 10 years?

Student Center

The student center, which also serves as a lobby for the

Carter Activities Center, has been used by tens of thousands of students, parents, and guests over the last decade. On September 16, 2009, a blade was lowered on a bulldozer and made the first cut to start the construction of the 3,080 square foot structure. The construction continued through the winter months and was completed 236 days later on May 10, 2010 as CRC hosted a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony that was attended by board members, students, faculty, staff, and many from the Paragould Community.

The \$320,000 project was 100% donor funded by 196 loyal and dedicated CRC donors. The seed gift to



start the project was a \$100,000 anonymous gift from a family that stated they wanted to give toward a project that would immediately connect with our students and fulfil a need on campus. The Mabee Foundation made a \$63,000 grant based on the strong donor interest in the project. Seven families gave \$10,000 or more each. A plaque in the student center honors those who gave \$1,000 or more.

The student center has been a tremendous blessing

for CRC students and because of its connection to the Carter Activities Center, it is used daily by the majority of our students. Most visitors to campus make their way to the student center. It has become the focal point of campus activity over the last decade.

Bachelor's Degrees

Since the founding of CRC in 1964, two progress themes continued to be promoted and discussed as a sign that the CRC was maturing as an institution. The two themes were Regional Accrediting and the college becoming a 4 Year College. Regional Accrediting, through the Higher Learning Commission, was achieved in 2000. CRC's full approval to offer Bachelor Degrees, as granted by the Arkansas Department of Higher Education, came in 2008 with those degrees falling under the Accreditation umbrella of the Higher Learning Commission.

- Bachelor of Science in Accounting
- Bachelor of Science in Marketing
- Bachelor of Science in Sports Management

WE NEED YOUR HELP TO PURCHASE THIS HOUSE

\$120,000

A few weeks ago, an appeal letter from President Hoppe was mailed regarding a house near CRC's campus that the college bought to meet our growing student housing needs projected for this fall. Your financial support is needed to help pay for this house.

\$120,000 is needed to buy a house next to CRC for student housing needs.

THE GOOD NEWS:

- \$120,000 is the price that CRC paid, which is under the current market value.
- It is a 2,600 square foot house with three bedrooms and three bathrooms.
- Sits on nearly an acre at the corner of Highway 412 and the new bypass.
- The house is located 132 feet from the campus of Crowley's Ridge College.
- Located next to Hillcrest Church of Christ. CRC holds daily chapel/other classes at Hillcrest.
- Overall, the house is in good shape.

THE NOT SO GOOD NEWS:

- House came up for sale so quickly that CRC did not have time to raise money to buy it.
- Built in 1980, so it is a 39-year-old house.
- Will require minor repairs, but mostly cosmetic, including repainting.

WHY CRC NEEDS YOUR HELP TO PURCHASE THIS HOUSE:

As President Hoppe mentioned in his recent appeal letter, our admissions staff have been working very hard to reach their recruitment goals for new students. Comparing

numbers for this same time as last year, we do not have enough residential student beds to take care of the estimated number of students that we believe are planning to attend CRC this fall 2019.

While we will do plan to build dormitories and other buildings, we could not pass up this easy access to more student beds given our projection of growing student numbers this fall 2019. We are working with firms regarding architectural plans, a campus master plan, and a permanent solution for infrastructure improvements. Purchasing this house is a blessing. However, we need your help in being able to pay for it since we had to act so quickly in the buying the house.

CRC WELCOMES CARISSA WINN

Carissa (Foshee) Winn, ED.S, LPC of Paragould has recently joined the CRC family. She will be the **new Lady Pioneer Head Volleyball Coach, Assistant Professor of Psychology and Sociology, and will be CRC's Designated Counselor.** She graduated from CRA and her husband, Jonathan, is a CRC alumni.

Carissa received her B.S. in Child and Family Studies from Freed-Hardeman University in 2011 where she played collegiate volleyball for four years. She is ninth on the All-Time Career list at FHU for most digs totaling 779. She played a major role in the Lions defense during her career helping Freed go 100-40 through her four seasons. That included an undefeated Regular Season Tran South Athletic Conference Championship, three TSAC conference tournament championships, and reaching the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball National Tournament Final Site for the first time in program history her senior year in 2011.

She went on to earn her Specialist in Education in Mental Health Counseling from ASU in 2014. She is currently working on her Master of Science in School Counseling and previously worked for Mid-South Health Systems as a School Based Therapist and Mental Health Professional with the Greene County Tech school district.

Carissa currently coaches the Arkansas Juniors Storm volleyball club team out of Brookland, AR. Coach Winn replaces former CRC Head Volleyball Coach Barry

Wheeler, who recently accepted a position as Head Volleyball Coach at Oklahoma Christian University.

She believes her experience as a collegiate athlete and the lessons she has learned from other coaches will enhance her ability to lead this team.

Coach Winn shares, *"First and most importantly, I wouldn't have had the opportunities and experiences I have had without God and I am so grateful and excited to be able to share these through the sport of volleyball and within a Christian environment. My parents and family have supported me in my role as a player and now as a coach and I will always be so thankful for all of the time they invested in me. My husband has been and continues to be a huge source of support and encouragement. We actually met playing volleyball on the sand court at CRC nine years ago, so I feel like this opportunity brings things somewhat full circle for us. I have also had several wonderful coaches, teammates, and friends that have taught me so much about the sport and shared their knowledge and experiences that will help me in this new role."*
